Under Americaâ€™s first governing document, the Articles of Confederation, the national government was weak and states operated like independent countries. At the 1787 convention, delegates devised a plan for a stronger federal government with three branchesâ€”executive, legislative and judicialâ€”along with a system of checks and balances to ensur
