The present paper discusses universal access to health-care in the light of the barriers faced by some vulnerable individuals and groups due to caste based identities. Factors such as perception of self, availability of services, sensitivity of the providers determine access and consequently affect utilization among vulnerable populations. Inaccessibility of clean water sources, hygiene and sanitation facilities negatively impacts among others health, education, the ability to work, and the ability to partake in social activities. This paper looks at the benefits of, and access barriers to, clean water and sanitation for people with disabilities.
