In the article "The virtue approach to moral education" that was published in the Journal of Philosophy of Education in 1997, Steutel explains that his theory of virtues is not a virtue approach for two reasons. Firstly, it is argued that a virtue approach takes aretaic concepts and judgements as basic or fundamental (it is an aretaic ethics: 1997, p. 403) while his own theory of virtues is based on principles. He does, however, offer alternatives to the psychologists that may assist them in moving beyond this impasse.
