In a radical situation of a forced choice, in which because of slavery relations Sita's children weren't hers at all, the only way to protect them, to save their dignity, was to kill them. The character of Sita's act becomes clear if we compare it with what is perhaps one of its literary models, William Styron's "Sophie's Choice", in which the heroine, confronted with the choice of saving one of her two children from the gas chamber, concedes to this blackmail by the Nazi officer and sacrifices her older daughter in order to save. I claim that at its most radical, Kant's ethics of autonomy does not mean that the categorical imperative is a kind of neutral black box machine. For example, somebody tells me: "That is your duty." Kant's first formulation of the categorical imperative is an understanding about how to determine if an action is right or wrong, and it states, "Act only in accordance with that maxim through which you can at the same time will that it become a universal law." I take this to mean "act only in accordance with reasons that would apply to all similar situations." Rewilding "the ethical imperative. Written by William S. Lynn. Published in Opinions. I was there to talk about the ethics of managing wolves and other large carnivores, and what the implications are for current and future public policy. After the talk I was asked if we simply needed to accept with grace the loss of wildlife and wildness. That with the advent of the anthropocene, it was too late for wild nature much less rewilding. Moreover, we are inextricably nested in landscapes of ecological and social relations. This means we can help or harm others, and that makes how we treat animals and the rest of nature of direct moral concern. When it comes to rewilding, then, it is not solely an effort to save biodiversity and create ecological stability for human well being " as crucial as that is.
