Although regionalism may be viewed as an alternative to multilateralism, in the East Asian context there may be little conflict between the two, at least in their economic consequences. Duty payments on intra-Asian trade tend to be low as a result of trade liberalisation and of the prevalence of duty-drawback systems in response to the production fragmentation and networks which emerged over the last two decades. Trade costs are measured by the gap between cost-insurance-freight (i.e. landed value in an importing country) and free-on-board (i.e. value at the point of exit from the exporting country) values of exports from each country to a common destination.
