Martha Graham began to work with male dancer Erick Hawkins. They started their partnership in 'American Document' and went on to dance together in many other dances. Graham eventually married Hawkins in 1948 but it ended in 1950 after a passionate relationship. It was said to have a personal connection to Graham's own life and her relationship with her two sisters. In an interview later in life Martha said, "the work is not a mirroring of my life, but speaks to anyone who has a family.
