Ms. Faludi talked about her book, *Stiffed: The Betrayal of the American Man*, published by William Morrow. She focused on her decision to write the book and the resulting criticism. She examined the anger and discontent of the American male, blaming it on a variety of factors from corporate downsizing to a shrinking military to the departure of sports teams to other cities. After her prepared remarks she answered questions from the audience.
