Die weiße Einsamkeit by Reinhold Messner is Essays & Memoirs 1970 gelang den Brüdern Messner die Überschreitung des Nanga Parbat. Nirgendwo liegen für ihn Triumph und Tragödie so eng beieinander. »Die weiße Einsamkeit« ist eine Geschichte zwischen Schuld und Schicksal sowie die bewegte Chronik jenes Berges. 2005 endlich wurde mithilfe einer DNA-Analyse eindeutig nachgewiesen, dass Günther Messner erst nach der gemeinsamen Überschreitung am Fuß der Diamirwand des Berges
