On the 114th anniversary of Misuzu Kaneko's birth, we spoke with David Jacobson about the editorial decisions involved relating a tragedy to young readers, the unique charms of Misuzu's poetic vision, and the ability of a poet writing at the beginning of the 20th century to find resonance with readers all around today's world. We felt that was especially important since one of the hallmarks of Misuzu's career was the emotional honesty she offered to her readers. From a writerly perspective, what are the things that most appeal to you about Misuzu's verse? Does time have a beginning and end? Illustrator Toshi Hajiri complements the poem brilliantly by envisioning a child jumping rope, which divides night and day. We struggled a long time trying to translate this poem.
