Creating a stained glass pattern in Photoshop is a simple task. Simply select the stained glass pattern effect from Photoshop's effects menu and apply it your photo or illustration. From there, you can then apply other Photoshop effects to add an extra touch of brilliance and realism. Step 1. Activate Photoshop and create the Photoshop file. Select "New" on the main menu bar. Type "Stainedglass" in the Name text box in the dialog box that appears. Select "OK" to close the dialog box. Step 2.
