Fifthly, power (used in political science) is a very complex notion. How it is used, what consequences it produces, how it is to be achieved—all are in real sense complex. No simple analysis can unearth the various aspects of power. The corporate body began to influence the policy making and policy implementing functions of the state authority. Thus, in a capitalist society there are at least two (and in many cases more than two) centres of power—one is state and the other is corporate. This relation between power and authority has been stated by Leslie Lipson in the following words. “What demarcates authority from power is that the former is power recognised as rightful. Authority is government that all accept as valid.”
