The Criminal Investigations Division (CID) of the FBI is still the largest major division in the Bureau, supporting more than 4,800 Special Agent jobs. Within this division, the emphasis is on preventing crimes related to national security, such as interrupting financial networks that provide support to terrorist organizations. A large number of personnel are also allocated to violent crimes, financial crimes, and organized crime. The Breadth and Scope of Special Agent Jobs in the Criminal Investigations Division. Upholding civil rights and preventing public corruption are among the major priorities.

The Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) is the domestic intelligence and security service of the United States, and its principal federal law enforcement agency. Operating under the jurisdiction of the United States Department of Justice, the FBI is also a member of the U.S. Intelligence Community and reports to both the Attorney General and the Director of National Intelligence. A leading U.S. counter-terrorism, counterintelligence, and criminal investigative organization, the FBI has jurisdiction in any such investigation, the FBI would consider all possibilities—including that an accident was at fault or that an attack was to blame. This is standard procedure. The only certainty at this point is that the public will not know exactly what occurred until the FBI decides it is appropriate to release more information.
