Its role in the social sciences is the study of the fundamental principles and concepts of social life in their epistemological and axiological aspects. The epistemological aspect is concerned with the question of knowledge; and the axiological aspect deals with the questions of value. The former deals with the fundamental principles and concepts of social life such as man, society, justice, happiness, etc. Social sciences may deal with means, but social philosophy deals with ends without disregarding the means. As Ginsberg says, "Social philosophy is bound to be the golden crown of the social sciences." Home
